The University of Bielsko-Biala was founded in October 2001 as an independent governmental academic institution. At present, about 5,000 students study at five faculties: Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Computer Science; Faculty of Materials, Civil and Environmental Engineering; Faculty of Management and Transport; Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, and Faculty of Health Sciences. The University employs about 400 people, including 200 experienced professors and other academic staff. The program's blended approach, combining theoretical understanding through remote lectures and practical application in stationary sessions,









ensures participants gain a comprehensive skill set in personal development.
